GARDEN LIME

Introduction

- **Garden Lime corrects acid soils, especially in high rainfall areas where lime may be leached from the soil.**
- **Increases soil pH which helps nutrients become more available to the plant**
- **Helps aerate heavy soils.**
- **Aids as a composting agent. Just add lime to your compost pile to help break down organic matter.**
- **Contain Magnesium and Calcium which assist in plant growth.**
- **Ideal for use when growing:**
*Sweet peas, peas, chrysanthamums, roses,
cactus, corn, paw paw.*

Available in 3kg and 5kg sizes.



When Should I Apply

Apply Brunnings Garden Lime once per year.

How Much Do I Use

For heavily manured garden beds such as vegetables, apply at a rate of 150g per square metre and water in.

For flower beds apply at 75g per square metre and water in.

For lawns apply an amount of lime in Winter equal the total amount of lawn food applied during the year.

Active Ingredients

32.5%	Calcium (Ca) as Calcium Carbonate
2.7%	Magnesium (Mg) as Magnesium Carbonate

- *DO NOT APPLY GARDEN LIME TO 'ACID LOVING' PLANTS SUCH AS AZALEAS, CAMELLIAS AND RHODODENDRONS.*
