## AFRICAN VIOLET MIX

### Introduction

- Specially formulated for the needs of African Violets.
- Open free draining mix.

Available in 5L size.

### For Best Results

#### **Positioning of Pots:**

- Do not place African Violets in direct sunlight. Medium to bright light will be sufficient.
- Rotate plants growing in natural light by turning them 90° each day to avoid lop sided growth.

#### **Watering:**

- Do not over-water, allow surface of potting mix become touch dry before watering and use tepid, not cold water.
- When watering African Violets, avoid getting water on the crowns and leaves.
- African Violets should be routinely watered from the bottom. Place pot into shallow dish of water for about 20 minutes, discard excess water.
- African Violets will benefit from being occasionally watered from the top, using warm water, as this will wash away any salts that may accumulate.

#### **Artificial Light**

Using a stand, place plants 40cm apart from tubes and over a number of weeks move them closer until they are within 25cm of the tubes. Plants under artificial light must have 8 hours of darkness in each 24 hour period.

#### **Temperature:**

African Violets require a warm temperature of 16-21°C with humidity at 40-60%. Avoid draughts and any sudden changes in temperature.
